


# French and Indian War Vocabulary

Ally (Alliance) - People or Country working together

Frontier - the areas on the edge Wilderness

Expansion - becoming larger

Union (Unite) - Coming together with a common purpose

Formal proposal - a written document saying what should be done

Political Cartoon - A picture explaining an event or message.

Surrender - To give up

Treaty - Written agreement at the end of a war

To Proclaim (Proclamation) - announce in public

Banned - not allowed

  - \* Showed Leadership
  - \* Sent to Ohio River Valley
  - \* Built Fort Necessity
- Benjamin Franklin -
  - \* Albany Plan of Union - 1st formal proposal to unite the colonies
  - \* Join or Die - Political cartoon to unite colonies as a group.

## The End of the War

- \* England won!
- \* Treaty of Paris of 1763 is signed
- \* England gets all of France's land east of the Mississippi River.


