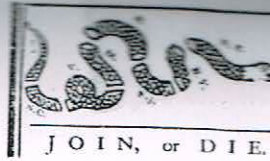
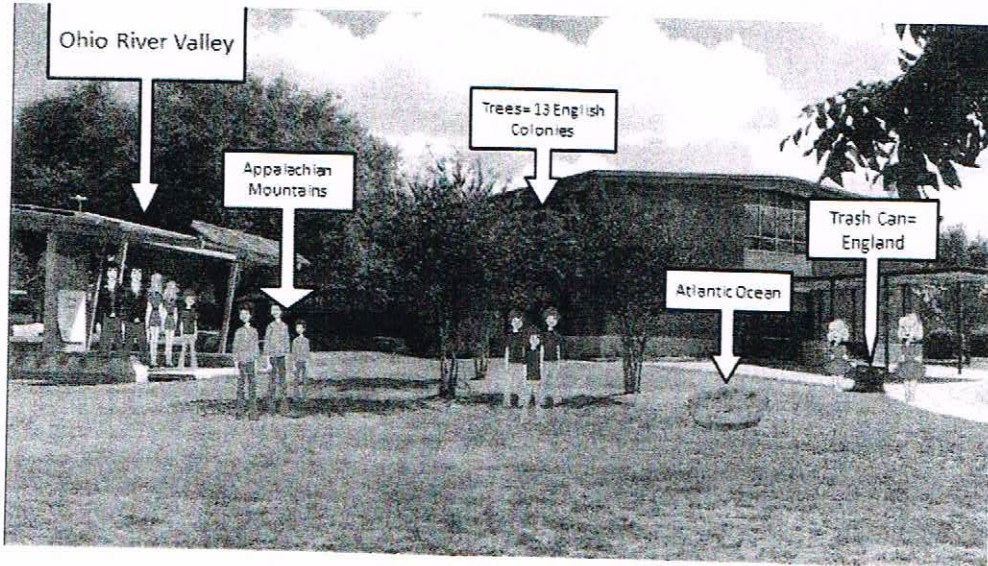

Ally (Alliance) - People or Country Working together

Frontier - the areas on the edge wilderness

Expansion - becoming larger

Union (unite) - coming together with a common purpose

Formal proposal - a written document saying what should be done

Political Cartoon - A picture explaining an event or message.

Surrender - to give up

Treaty - written agreement at the end of a war

To Proclaim (Proclamation) - announce in public

Banned - not allowed

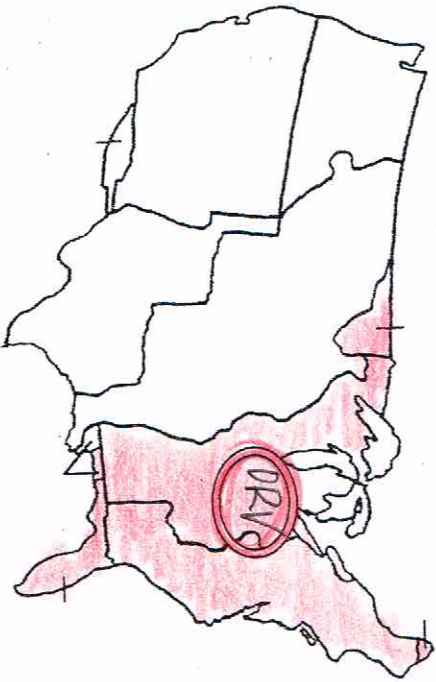
