


Mississippi River.

Thomas Jefferson (3rd president) purchased the Louisiana Territory from France in 1803. America almost doubled the size of the United States.






Louisiana Purchase 1803

President James Monroe, the 5th president, purchased Florida from Spain in 1819. Florida was given to the United States under the Adam-Onis Treaty.






Texas

Texas gained its independence from Mexico in 1835. The United States annexed (added) Texas that was independent of 10 years. The Annexation (addition) of Texas upset Mexico. Annexation of Texas led to the U.S.- Mexico War.



Territorial Acquisitions- Oregon




Oregon




